## Curriculum Enhancement

**Bible Class** - Bryte Christian Academy teachers teach Bible class every morning for half an hour as part of the daily curriculum. The children learn how to follow Christ in all areas of life. They learn Christian songs and Bible verses. This is a time for the children to ask questions, ask for prayer, and learn to pray for one another.

**Chapel** - We have chapel once a week on Mondays, from 8:35-9:15. Children learn the importance to worship together as a school community. Teachers, special guests, and pastors take turns to bring meaningful and applicable Bible lessons to the students.

**Physical Education** - our students participate in physical education once a week. This is a time where they learn hand/eye coordination skills, team playing, sport and game techniques, and memorize anatomical terms.

## Tell me more about BCA

The Bryte Christian Academy is a Christian private school, serving students in kindergarten through eighth grade. Our school was founded in 2015 as a part of Bryte Church. We provide a family oriented, Christian-based intimate learning environment that is devoted to the academic, social, linguistic, and personal success of each child based on biblical values. The Bryte Christian Academy has the primary objective of enabling its students to become self-motivated, competent, and lifelong learners of Christ and His word.

## How does a student enroll?

- Fill out an application packet
- Interview will be scheduled with all new families

Students enrolling in K5 program must turn five on or before December 31<sup>st</sup>. Once in a while, an exception can be made based on pre-enrollment testing, interviews with the teacher and Principal, and other special circumstances.



## When does school begin?

Orientation & Meet-n-Greet Night: August 19<sup>th</sup>, at 6:30-8:00pm.

**The first day of school is August 21<sup>st</sup> at 8:30am.**

## Daily Schedule

8:30am - 2:45pm 4 days/week

8:30am -1:45pm Fridays

## What is the cost?

Tuition rates per pay period for the 2024-2025 school year are as follows:

K5 through 10<sup>th</sup> grade: \$695

K5 through 10<sup>th</sup> grade (Bryte Church members): \$630

*Additional one-time expenses:*

Registration: \$100 per child

Curriculum \$500 per child

The tuition for each child is based on a ten period pay plan. The first payment is due by September 10<sup>th</sup>, or the student's place will be forfeited. Subsequent tuition payments are due the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month. The last payment is due by June 10<sup>th</sup>. The registration fee is nonrefundable and nontransferable.
