


## AUGUST NEWSLETTER - 2024 NEWS FROM THE DEPARTMENTS AND CHURCHES OF THE ASSOCIATION

On August 21, Aleksey Timofeyevich Kozorezov passed away. He was the minister and pastor who endured a lot during his life at the hands of the Soviets for preaching the Gospel and having an active church ministry. He immigrated to the U.S. and settled in Seattle, WA in 1991. That same year he became a pastor at the local church, and soon afterward, he became a part of the Pacific Coast Slavic Baptist Association's committee, where he continued to serve until 2015. He was also a spiritual mentor at the Association.

Beginning in 2019, he was bedridden due to an

illness, but continued to be strong in the Lord and rely on the Lord. His suffering is now over, and this faithful minister of God has found his eternal peace at the feet of his Lord and Savior, whom he followed all of his life.


The search for speakers who will be able to unpack these important topics is underway. The Association's department leaders and Committee members are

#### A BANK DESIGNED FOR CHRISTIANS

After Nick Vujicic, an evangelist and a well-known speaker who was born without arms and legs, began to actively speak against abortions, he experienced true persecution. Even more than that. "I was locked out of my bank without any warning. They froze my credit cards and my debit cards," he said. "They gave me a letter in which they said that they looked at me as a customer and decided that they don't want to have anything to do with me." This was not the only thing that he and other Christians have to endure as they speak against the murder of innocent children. This motivated Nick to create a group of like-minded people and create a bank that will act according to Christian principles, and will be geared toward Christians. The grand opening of ProLifeBank is estimated to be in November of this year.
