"Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among men with whom He is pleased!" (Luke 2:14)



THE GOSPEL BEHIND BARBED WIRE

"Millions of Russians for Christ" was the original motto of the Russian Christian Radio, organized and overseen by the father of Yarl Nikolayevich Peysty, Nikolay Ivanivich Peysty. This ministry exists to this day, and has truly helped millions of people come to God. From the first day when the Russian Christian Radio was organized in 1946, the Gospel has been proclaimed not only over the radio, but also through personal outreach by going to churches and sending letters to inmates. In 1994, Pirkko Home Liberation Center Ministry – Adaptation was organized, and since 1995, the magazine "The Gospel Behind Barbed Wire" has been published. In addition, in 1995, they started to print a magazine titled, "Evangelism Behind Barbed Wire." The magazine's 6th issue of 2024 can be found here (in Russian only).





Many conservative Christians are concerned about how God is depicted in contemporary churches, and the methods that the churches use in order to attract people to church. Oftentimes the methods that the churches use have nothing in common with Christianity. People are incentivized to come to church but are not led to Christ, to God.

Christian organization Media Gratiae has developed an online training course, "Behold Your God," in which John Snyder and many other famous ministers talk about how well-known Christians (Aiden Tozer,

Timothy Dwight, George Muller, and many others) approached this issue, and what they did.
